****Please note: We need everyone to please sign up and pay by Sunday, November 13th so we can get the final head count to the caterer.****



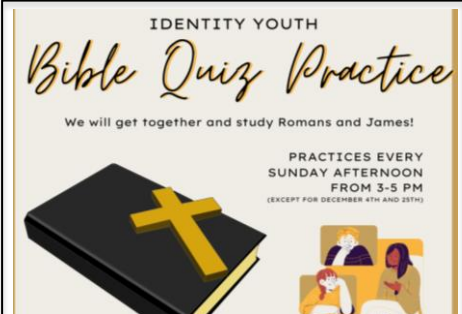

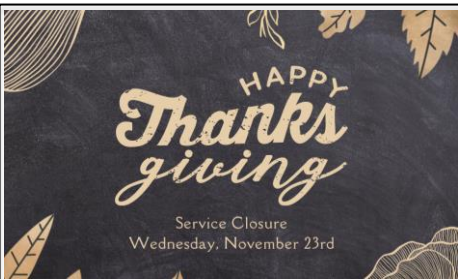
